to God for the same but now calling to mind that it is
proper for all men once to die do make and ordain
this my last Will and testament in manner and form
following viz. My soul I bequeath to god who giveth
my body to the dust from which it was taken to be buried
in a decent manner, and as to the worldly goods with
which it has pleased god to bless me I dispose of them
in the following manner.

Item 1st I give to my beloved wife Elizabeth two Negro men
by the name of Peter and Simon also a negro woman named
Jane during the term of her natural life.

Item 2nd I give to my son Nathan H. Davis three Negro boys
by the name of Thomas Samuel & William.

Item 3rd I give my son Elijah Davis a Negro man named
Henry a negro boy named Jacob and a negro woman
named Dennis and her child Maria.

Item 4th I give to my son Nathan Davis two negro boys named
Elijah and Benjamin, also at his mother death a negro
man named Simon.

Item 5th I give to my son Sipe H. Davis two negro boys named
Peter and Simon, and a negro girl named Caroline
and at his mother death Peter and Jane.

Item 6th I give to my daughter Matilda Davis a negro woman
named Annie.

Item 7th I give to my daughter Sabra Davis a negro woman
named Julia.

Item 8th I leave to my daughter Lydia a negro girl named
Betty during her natural life and at her death
