

In the name of God Amen, I Francis Dennis of the
County of Lancashire do this day of November 1828 make
and publish this to be my last will and testament
in form and manner following that is to say,

Stein

I give and bequeath unto my wife Anne unto my four
children: Reuben and my Daughter Frances and all of
that land I bought of my Brother Reuben Dennis his part
of said land that lies between where I now live and where
Brother James Dennis formerly lived and also seventy two acres
lying on hills swamp being the land I bought of Cady and
from my eastward across fence that divides my Brother and
me to a certain place that stands to the westward of my
house where I now live supposed to be about six hundred
yards and to include all of the back land - one half of
stocks both cattle and hogs sheep and my horses and
then their heirs and assigns forever from the first day
westward I give unto my four children Polly, William, Luke
& Fletcher to be equally divided and amongst them their heirs
and assigns forever - I give my negro man ^{one} and my
woman Peg unto my four children to be Polly Easter and wife
for ever.

Item I give unto my wife all of my Dishes and household
furniture and all of my Provision that I have now on hand
for the support of my wife and my two Children Debbie
and Trouser, and also I give unto my wife Comfort and
my two Children Debbie & Trouser and Debbie my wife
Mary Abraham. Unto them were heirs and assigns for
ever and also I give unto my wife all of my forming
and Plantation tools Unto her for ever
and Lastly I do appoint my wife Comfort to be
my Executive to this my last will and testament
which here I set my hand and seal to the day
and date before written

In the Name of God Amen James Dixon being in perfect Mind
and memory and in good health and knowing that it is appri-
mated for all men ymours to die los make and ordain this my
Last will and testamant wht is first of all I recommend my
soul to god wht give it and my Body to be Buried in a
christian Like manner at the discretion of my friends and as
for such worldly good as it has bin please god to bless me
with as followeth first I desire all my just debts to be paid
and the rest as follows—

I give to my well beloved wife Elizabeth my Luns and
Lang and all my moveable property and after her Deceas to
my Grandson James Dixon III son of mych Dixon.

I give to my two sons Ulrich and James the
Chattel and other things that they have received and know more

I give to my Daughter Barbara five Shillings Sterling
and I further give to my Daughter Lizzie ten Shillings and other
things that she has received and not more.—

And I appoint my son Ulrich and John Roberto my
Executors to this my last will testament and in witness
whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this
sixth day of October - 1810
