I give and bequath to my well beloved son Thomas Dudley all the Land I hold on the Blawie Swamp and other where Except that parcel att Greene Creek and that to be sold for schooling my Children & likewise one silver Spoon & one Church Bible one bow and half Balld Bow and one young mair Balld Pomog and all my tools of of Every sort Except the plow here and 2 axes and Cross Cut saw Likewise two guns for his comfort and support during his Natural Life.

I likewise give and bequath to my loving Daughter Elizabeth Dudley one Negro man called Jerimee at full age or marriage & one bow balld fust for her comfort and support during her Natural life

I give and bequath to my loving wife Mary Dudley all the Remainer part of my Estate in what part so ever and where so ever for her comfort and support during her Natural life and I constitute and appoint John Back house and Jacob Dudley Executors of this last will and Testament Revoking all other wills made by me at any time and Declaring this only to be my last will and Testament Whereunto I have hereunto set my hand and first my seal This Twenty-fifth day of May in the year of our Lord god 1702
