Item I Give and devise to my said wife Nancy
all of my Household and Kitchen furniture
except one Bed

Item I Give and devise to my said wife Nancy
Three Hundred Dollars in money.

Item I Give to my said wife Nancy all of my
March Ponies together with all of my farming
utensils

Item I Give and devise to my two Grandsons
John. C. Davis and Martin. T. Davis all of
my Out Land

Item After the Death of my wife Nancy
it is my desire that I Give to my

Grandsons John. C. Davis and Martin. T.
Davis the House and Land on which I now
live

I Give and devise to my Grand Daughter
Sarah C. Willis the House and Land on
which she now lives

I Give and devise to my Daughter Jane
Davis, John. C. Davis and Martin T. Davis.
the residue of all moneys, not otherwise
disposed of Shall and shall also.

I Give and devise to Marinda Fulford
Daughter of Abs R. Fulford one Bed.

And Lastly I do hereby constitute and
appoint my Trusty Friends John. C. Davis and
John. A. Whitcheur my Lawful Executors
to all intents and purposes, to Execute
this my Last will and Testament according
to the true intent and meaning of the same
and every part and clause thereof hereby
proving, and declaring utterly void all other
wills and Testaments by me made
