

In the name of God, amen, I John Rustell, Senr of said County. Considering the Uncertainty of this mortal life, and being of sound and perfect mind & memory, blessed be allmighty God for the same, do make and publish this my last will and Testament in manner and form following (that is to say) First, I give and bequeath unto my son John Rustell my plantation and all that I bought of Isaac White, one hundred & fifty acres more or less, the dwelling house & one bend and furniture, my books, and my household tools, I also give and bequeath unto my daughter Francis Norris twenty five acres of land, I also give and bequeath unto my Grand son William Brown twenty five acres of land. I also give and bequeath unto my Grand son Log Rustell one Cow and Calf, and all the rest of my Estate to be held and divided equally among my children, and the aforesaid land that I give unto my daughter Francis Norris and my Grand son William Brown, I dole to give the first offer to my children, and if William Brown my Grand son be before he comes of age, for that twenty five acres of land to his two Sisters that is Katherine Brown and her sister Mary Brown, and further more if William Brown the Father of William Brown should bring claim or demand against my Estate after my death, I then herein doth put my Grand son William Brown, of my part or part of the legacy I above mentioned, or his two sisters that is Katherine & Mary Brown, should the said William Brown be before he comes of age, that is upon provision if the said William Brown, the Father of the aforesaid three children should bring any amount against my Estate after my death, otherwise it is to remain as before mentioned. In witness whereof the said John Rustell have to this my last will & Testament set my hand and seal this 11th day of July and in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and twenty seven.
