

In the name of God Amen I Joseph Davis of the County of Hatteras in the State of North Carolina - Being now in Boddy But in perfect mind and memory - and being to mind the mortality of my Boddy - do make and declare this my Last will and Testament - in manner and form as follows.

Item And first I give and Bequeath to my son William Davis the plantation he now Lives on containing two hundred acres Lying on the West side of the Oyster Creek and fifty acres on the East-Side - To him and his heirs for ever.

Item I give to my son Thomas Davis one eighth part of my plantation where I now Live, upon by the name of the Island beginning at the Dwelling house, and running and last come to the sound, he having the south side and the West house in the Dwelling house - I give to my Loving Wife the north side of my plantation and to his Estate house in my Dwelling house (Line Town)

My son Thomas and his heirs - I likewise give to my son Thomas Davis ninety eight acres of land which is in two parcels adjoining the Island - I likewise give to my son Thomas Fifty acres of land on the east side of the Oyster Creek - and sixty one acres of Barren land to him and his heirs for ever - I give to my son Joseph my Large Bible - I give and Bequeath to my son Roddy one Acre - I give to my Loving Wife During her Widowhood all my stock of all kinds, and after her Decease to be Equally Divided Between all my Daughters - my will and desire is that in case my Daughters should want, or be in need of a horse or any other kind of my stock I do hereby authorize and it is hereby invested in her to Dispose to such person or persons as she shall think fit -

Item and lastly I appoint my two sons William and Thomas Davis my Executors, to this my Last will and Testament and I do hereby revoke all former Will or Wills heretofore by me made - In Testimony Whereof I have to this my Last Will and Testament - Set my hand and seal this Seventeenth Day of February one thousand seven hundred and ninety two -

Know all Men by these presents that I Joshua Danner of Currituck County and State of North Carolina being very weak in body yet in my proper senses and having called to mind that it is now appointed for all Men to die and considering myself that the near I ordain and acknowledge this to be my Last will and Testament and first of all I leave my body to be buried in a Christian like manner at the discretion of my Executors and secondly I will that my worldly goods be distributed as follows; that is to say after paying my just Debts I leave to my dear son John Danner when he comes to age one half share between him and three years old by the name of Francis also one by call by the name of Francis I leave to my oldest Daughter Mary Danner and after this I leave to my well beloved wife Mary Danner all my property of Every kind in during her Life or Widowhood and at the death of them death or Marriage I will that an Equal Division be made amongst all my Children and hereby acknowledge this to be my Last will and Testament - sealed Signed in the presence of us December 11 day 1799 Joshua Danner ^{his} Danner Seal
also I will that my beloved wife Mary Danner and Joseph Danner be my Executors
