testament utterly recollecting all former wills made by me
declaring this to be my last will and testament
1st I give my body to be buried and my soul to

2nd I give and bequeath unto my wife and daughter
Jerry Sulford and Jane Ann Gaskill my house and land
with all the appurtenances also all my land on Hog Island
with at the death of my wife Dorcas Gaskill. I further
give unto the said Jerry Sulford and Jane Ann Gaskill
all my personal property at the death of my said wife
Dorcas Gaskill said personal property consists of
and appurtenances with house hold and kitchen
furniture with all my Appurtenances tools &c.

I leave to my wife Dorcas Gaskill my house and
where I now live also I leave to her my site to the land
on Hog Island &c. I furthermore leave to her the
Dorcas Gaskill all my house hold and kitchen furniture
with all the rest of my personal property to her the said
Dorcas Gaskill for her use during her natural lifetime

I do hereby constitute and appoint my trusty
John L. Goodwin and Geo. W. Emory executors to the

Know all men by these presents that I Josiah Daniels
of the said State and County

do make and ordain this my last will and testament
1st I give and bequeath to my son Randolph Daniels Fifty
acres where he now lives and forty acres lying to the South
west of the wolver den and twenty five acres back of the
great pond, and sixty acres lying between the head of the bay
and Brown point fifty ~~and~~ acres of marsh called the beach island
which I give to my two sons Randolph Daniels and Aaron
Daniels, I also give Randolph Daniels one bed which he has had
I also give to my son Randolph Daniels one canoe and also my
site to the house on Long Banks.

2nd I give to my Daughter Clarissa Daniels one bed which
she has and five dollars in money.

3rd I give to my son Aaron Daniels the place where I now live
one hundred of land lying on the South west side of the North
bay one bed and bedstead and my site to the Nets and my
site to the horse at the North bay and my working tools

4th I give to my Daughter Delila Daniels one bed and bedstead
one cow and calf her choice and also two whips and also my
