In the Name of God amen, I Malachi Bell of Courteret County
in the State of North Carolina, being of sound and perfect mind
Blessed be God, do this 22nd day of September in the year of our
Lord one thousand eight hundred and three, Make and Publish
this my Last Will and Testament in manner following that
is to say.

First-

I bind unto my beloved wife Sarah Bell during her Natural
Life my House and the Easternmost part of my plantation I
now own to be divided by a line of marked trees, beginning at a
Mulberry tree marked for a corner standing on the back land now
and on the east side of a pond in my plantation which draws
into the sound on the west side of my House I now live in,
thence running N. West - meaning the same course of the land
belonging to Nancy Fulpford to the back line of my land including
all that part - next and joining Neshamith Creek with all the
Buildings thereon, the aforesaid Land and Buildings at the end
of my wife shall be the property of, and belong unto my son
David Bell as here after mentioned, Likewise grant and
give unto my wife free Liberty to make use of any timber for
Rails or fire wood for her own plantation or house near or
any part of the tract of Land I now live on, I also lend unto
my wife during her Natural Life the worse and service of my
Negro man named Cole, and at her Death the said Negro shall
be the property of my Grand Daughter Nancy Fulpford as here
after mentioned, Likewise I bind unto my wife during her
Natural Life the worse and service of my Negro man named
Slept - and at her Death the said Negro Slept to be the prop-
erty of my son Josiah Bell, I also lend unto my wife all my
House hold Furniture except my Desk and looking Glass,
I also lend unto my wife all my plantation tools my
coms and all my stock of coms of every kind for her support
during her Natural Life, at her Death to be divided with
my House hold Furniture (what ever may be in being or
found) among all my children both Sons and Daughters
and my Grand Daughter Nancy Fulpford and my wife,
three sons, I also lend unto my wife Sarah Bell my
Wind mill which is now building during her Natural
Life and I give unto her all the money now in my House
(belonging to me) to finish the said mill, but my four sons
and my two Daughters and my Grand Daughter Nancy Fulpford
to have their grinding done toll free.

Item

I give and bequeath unto my beloved wife Sarah Bell all
my lampfull right and title to four Negroes viz.

Daniel, Sam, Celia and her child being a boy named
Harford to her and to her Heirs and assigns for ever.

Item

I give and bequeath unto my son Josiah Bell two hundred
and eighty acres of land lying in the fork of Newport
River joining on the S. west branch being the land where
I formerly lived which Land I bought from John Louton
to him and to his Heirs and assigns for ever.

I also give and bequeath unto my said son Josiah
Bell my Negro man named Stephen to be his property
at the death of my wife, to him and to his heirs and
assigns for ever. same Land I have given him by exec.

Item

I give unto my two sons Malachi Bell and William
Bell all the westernmost-part-of my land and plantation
where I now live divided as aforesaid including all
that-part-lying between the Land left to my wife and
the Land belonging to Nancy Fulford to be equally
Divided between them, and the westernmost-part
joining the Land belonging to Nancy Fulford to be for
my son Malachi Bell and shall be his property
and the Easternmost-part joining the Land or part
left unto my wife to be for my son William Bell
and shall be his property excepting only timber and
fire wood on said Lands to my wife for her own plan-
tation and House use during her life, The aforesaid
Land divided and bounded as aforesaid more or less
I give and bequeath unto my two said sons Malachi
Bell and William Cole Bell to them and to their
Heirs and assigns for ever. Likewise I give and
bequeath unto my two said sons Malachi Bell
and William Cole Bell two hundred acres of
Land I bought from Isaac O'Brien lying in the fork
of Newport River to them and to their Heirs and assigns
for ever. also I give unto my two said sons one
Eating for fifty-acres of Land joining the aforesaid
Land to them and to their Heirs and assigns for ever
also I give and bequeath unto my two said sons
Malachi Bell and William Cole Bell fifty-acres
of Land on the banks being a Ranging Right
I bought from Norton Howard & wife to them
and to their Heirs and assigns for ever.

Item

I give and bequeath unto my son David Bell all that-

part of my plantation and Land, that I have left unto my
wife as aforesaid being the Easternmost-part from the marsh
Mulberry tree to Nelson Hill near more or less including the House
mill and all the buildings thereon, to be for his use and benefit at
the Death of my wife. (My three sons, Josiah, Malachi & William Bell
my two Daughters Susanna Scraft and Sarah Robertson and my
Grand Daughter Nancy Fulford, to have there grinding done toll
free excepted, to him and to his Heirs and assigns for ever.

I also give and bequeath unto my said son David Bell
two hundred acres of Land I bought from Brown lying in
the fork of Newport River, joining the land given unto my son
Josiah Bell, to him and to his Heirs and assigns for ever
also I give unto my said son David Bell my looking Glass

Item

I lend unto my Daughter Susanna Scraft during her natural
Life the word and service of the Negro mentioned as follows viz:
My Negro woman named Jane which I bought from David Bell
and her three children, named Daniel, Sam, and Moriah,
and I do hereby give and bequeath the aforesaid Negro named
Jane, Daniel, Sam and Moriah unto the children of my said
Daughter Susanna Scraft both sons and daughters to be
delivered to them clear of all charge at the death of my said Son
her Susanna, and to be equally divided among all her children
when the youngest of them come to the age of sixteen years, to
them and to their Heirs and assigns for ever.

Item

I give and bequeath unto my daughter Sarah Robertson and unto
my Grand Daughter Nancy Fulford two hundred acres of Land I
bought from Shepard and Roundtree where the mill now is
with the mill and buildings thereon, the mill swamp to be
the dividing line between them, the Westernmost-part for my
daughter Sarah Robertson and the Easternmost-part for my
Grand Daughter Nancy Fulford to them and to their Heirs
and assigns for ever.

Item

I give and bequeath unto my daughter Sarah Robertson my
Negro Woman named Rose and her Child named Peter
to her and to her Heirs and assigns for ever.

Item

I give and bequeath unto my grand Daughter Nancy Fulford
fifty-acres of Land lying in the fork of Newport joining
the Land I give unto my son Josiah Bell near the said
swamp, bounded to one by present, to her and to her Heirs
and assigns for ever. I also give unto my said Grand Daughter

Nancy Tuford my Negro man named Cole which is
lent unto my wife to be delivered to her at the death
of my wife to her and to her Heirs for ever, but if my
said Grand Daughter should die without Lawful issue
then and in that case I do hereby bequeath and devolve
the above and aforementioned gift of Land and Negro
Cole and it shall be null and void, and then I give
and bequeath the said Land and Negro named Cole
unto my four sons Jorish Bell, Malachi Bell, William
C. Bell and David Bell and unto my two Daughters
Durrance LeCraft and Sarah Robertson, to them and to
their Heirs and assigns for ever.

I give and bequeath unto my two sons Malachi Bell
and William Cole Bell my Negro man named Charles
to them and to their Heirs and assigns for ever.

I give and bequeath unto my Grand Sons Malachi Robertson
one lot in Beaufort Town which I bought from Robert
Williams, to him and to his Heirs and assigns for ever.

Also I give and bequeath unto my said Grand Son
Malachi Robertson all my Right and title unto my
young Negro boy named Daniel, to him and to his
Heirs and assigns for ever.

I give and bequeath unto my wife Sarah Bell and
unto my two sons Jorish Bell and David Bell my
quarter part of the Schooner Huzzard, to them and to
their Heirs and assigns for ever.

I give and bequeath my new plot unto my wife and unto
my four sons Jorish, Malachi, William Cole & David
Bell.

I give and bequeath unto my two Daughters Durrance
LeCraft and Sarah Robertson, my old plot;

I give unto my son Malachi Bell one half day labour,
and at them to be sown by Joseph Davis, I spoke to him for
them.

I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Sarah Robertson
my Mahogany Desk.

I give and bequeath unto my wife all my stock in trade
and all my provisions now in my house and all my
corn in the field not gathered.

Item

My will and desire is that all Negroes lent to me and given and
my children by my Father Joseph Bell be equally divided between
all my children and my Grand Daughter Nancy Tuford agrees
to this will,

Item

It is my will and desire that my Grand Daughter Nancy Tuford
shew her Liv with my wife and for her to have the care of all
the property belonging to my said Grand Daughter for her support
till she comes of age.

Item

my will and desire is that my after named Executore shall get
in and Reciev all my Debts and pay all my just and Lawful
Debts, and I hereby make and ordain my wife Sarah Bell
Executrix and my two sons Jorish Bell and Malachi Bell
Executore of this and to this my last will and Testament.

In witness whereof I the said Malachi Bell have to this
my last will and Testament set my hand and seal the year
and day above written.

I Malachi Bell Senr in the State of North Carolina do
this 22^d day of September 1803 make and Publish this my
Codicil to this my Last Will and Testament in the manner
following, that is to say, as I have given my Negro woman
Named Rose and her child called Bet to my daughter
Sarah Robertson, I do now lend the said Negro woman Rose
and her child called Bet unto my wife Sarah Bell during
her Life and at her Death to be delivered unto my said
Daughter Sarah Robertson, to be her property according
to my will, and Lastly it is my will and desire that
this present Codicil be annexed to and made part of my
Last will and Testament to all intents and purposes.
