Item 1 I give and bequeath to my daughter Mary my plantation
whom I know live with all the buildings and Improvements
unto belonging to her and her heirs forever, and all the lands
that are not hereafter mentioned or given a way in the same
manner as the plantation above mentioned.

Item 2 I give to my daughter Susan a piece of Woodland on the
side of my plantation, beginning at the mouth of a ditch on
the same and running parallel with said ditch a northwesterly
to a live oak and thence the same comes to a marked gum
branch as I have marked it out to her and her heirs for
ever and the said Susan will take up the note and
just act which my son Levi and David held against
Yephemiah Gauland but provided she shall fail to discharge
a bond made and acts then my desire is that the said lands
be equally divided between my two sons Levi and David.

Item 3 I give to my son Elijah all my lands in the late Swamp
land was given me by my father to him and his heirs forever.

Item 4 I give to my son Levi fifty cents to him and his heirs forever.

Item 5 I give to my son David fifty cents to him and his heirs forever.

Item 6 I give to my son John five cents each to him and his heirs forever.

I have by appoint as my Executors to this my last will and
testament my three sons Viz Elijah Levi and David in writing
whereof I have herunto set my hand and seal this 25th
day of February and thence and eight hundred and thirty
six

Mother 10 head of Hogs, and I give to my Mother 20 head of Sheep
and then I reserve my the within will be proved in open Court
March the 26th 1836.
