 Lord 1801 Oliver Piggott of the parsonage of St. Andrew in the County of
 Kent in England being in his full mind and perfect memory
 & memory thanks be to Almighty God thus calling to mind the
 certain State of this Transitory life and that all flesh must grudge
 unto Death when he should please God to call he make and
 declare this my last will in Testaments in manner and form following
 giving first I give and Recommend my soul to God that have
 it is me and my body I commit to the Earth to be decently buried
 at the Discretion of my Executors here after named, and as for
 the settling of my Temporal Estate and such goods & chattels as I
 possess as it hath pleased God to bless me with I give and
 dispose of the same in manner and form following. First I give
 to James Piggott My House and Lands where I now live during the
 Natural Life and at his Death I give the said Real Estate to
 Allen Piggott all my Lands to him and the Lawfull Behefit
 Heirs of his own Body for ever I also give to Allen Piggott one
 feather Bed and two Bowler Chairs and my gun I also
 give my Horse & Chaise and all my moveable property to my Brother
 John Piggott & James Piggott to be Equally Divided between them
 After all my just Debts is paid and hereby make and Appoint
 my Loving friend Zachens Green my full & sole
 Executor of this my Last Will and Testament hereby Revoking
 making and making Void all former Wills, Requested by me made and
 declaring this only to be my Last Will and Testament.
