I Peter F. Carraway
of the State of North Carolina & County of
Carteret Township now being in sound health
of Body and mind but knowing that all men are
Mortal and have to die I do make this my last
will and testament to dispose of my worldly
goods as follows: I give unto my son
Edward F. Carraway my house and plantation
and an op of the wooded land land to contain
one hundred Acres provide he makes a deed
to fifty Acres of land lying and running through
my plantation on which I now live give to him
by his given mother the Plantation home as the
near place on which I formerly lived in case he
my son Edward fails to comply with the condition
of this my will then the house and land before mentioned
shall go to my young children

I give 2 I give to my daughter Mary the Balance
of the said tract of land which is two hundred
Acres I all so give her 3 cows and calves which
she has one Red & doted and furnaminture I
give to my son Edward my Mule Ket Stone 3
I give to my son George F. Carraway the piece of
land on which he now lives Beginning at the
Mouth of the Neachlaw gut running up the
Sandy gut and swamp to River - one gum
tree so as to take in his heirs and Crib Glass
By the side of the Creek I state line to the paces
thence westwardly with the paces to the Eastward
Branch of the Swamp thence with said Branch
to the main Swamp thence down said Swamp
and Creek to the Beginning containing once to
Acres I give unto him the Red which he now has
in his pasture Stone 4 I give to my son Joseph M.
Carraway A tract of land which he now lives a

Beginning on the side of Jonathan's land
at the mouth of a ditch running with
2 Cords of the ditch A. State line to
old Common line thence with that line
A large pine mark thence a State line
A Mark gum just below the old wood
landings thence down the Creek to the
Beginning. Containing one hundred Acres
I give unto him the Red he has in
possession Stone 5. I give to my Beloved
wife and her Children my house and
plantation on which I now live and
All of my lands not before mentioned
stock of Every description household
furniture to her my Beloved wife during
her life After her life to be divided Between
Children or such ones of them as shall
survive at her death

I give to my son Benjamin L Carr
my loved wife I dow her by Appoint
and nominate my Beloved wife Jennet
Carrway Escabuck and my son Edmund
Carrway Executors to my will
