and other improvements, to have and to hold to
her and her heirs in fee simple forever.

Then I give and devise to my Daughter Catherine
one Red and Redshad to have and to have to
and her hairs in for single forever

I give and devise to my Daughter Caldonia
five acres of wood Land to have and to hold
to her and her heirs in fee Simple forever

Then I give and devise to my ^{free} Daughters Mary
Lawrence, Wisconsin Tillet, Rhoda J. Lawrence
and Charlotte Tillet all the residue of
my Wood Land not otherwise disposed of in
this my will and Testament, in equal propo-
rtion and share alike to have and to hold
to them and their heirs in fee simple forever

And Lastly — I do hereby constitute
and appoint my true Friend Alfred H. Chadwell
my beloved Executor to all intents and
purposes to execute this my Last will and
testament according to the true intent
and meaning of the same and

very just and claime thereof - hereby nothing
and declaring utterly void all other wills and
testaments by me heretofore made.
