

In the Name of God Amen.

I Samuel Chadwick of Carteret County being of sound Mind and Memory do make and ordain this as my Last Will and Testament in Manner and Form as follow:

I Lend to my Wife Anna Chadwick during Life or widowhood two Negro men And two women such as she may choose among the third Part of all my land in Carteret County the Mansion house to be included and All that part of our Stock of cattle that she has been the habbit of Calling hers with our household Furniture or as much of it as she may need with a sufficiency of plantation Tools to till her Land.

I give to my son Thomas Chadwick the house and part of Land that I bought of my Brother James Chadwick and the half of my E. River Land Reserving one third to his Mother her Lifetime of Each to him and his heirs forever.

I give to my son Anson Chadwick the land given me by my Father wherein I now live with the other half of my E. River Land Reserving one third to his mother her Lifetime of Each to him and his heirs forever.

I Lend to my Daughter Rebecca during her Natural Life A Negro girl named Lavinia then to her Lawful heirs forever. I Lend to my Daughter Anna A negro girl named Ruth During her Natural Life and then to go to her Lawful heirs forever.

I Lend to my Daughter Polly A Negro girl named Romeo During her Natural Life and then to her Lawful heirs forever. The three above mentioned Negro girls shall be given to my three Daughters as Extra and not to be divided from an equal Dividend in the rest which will be after word divided. My Desire is that all the Remaining part of my Negroes that are not hereditarily mentioned to be hired out those that will or are in a situation to be hired and the younger ones to be let out in the family or otherwise as may be thought proper until the decease of my wife and then for Judicious men to value them and divide them in the following manner in six equal parts.

One share to Thomas Chadwick and his heirs forever

I give to my son Anson Chadwick one part to him and his heirs forever.

I Lend unto my Daughter Rebecca one share during her Natural life After which to go to her Lawful

heirs for ever.

I Lend unto my Daughter Anna one share during her Natural life and then to her Lawfull heirs for ever.

I Lend unto my daughter Polly one share during her life and then to go to her Lawfull heirs for ever.

I Lend to my three Grand children Sam & Nancy Rumbly one share between them in the same way as to my daughters above.

Should I Leave my New river Land should I leave it be Rented out until an opportunity should offer to obtain a fair price for it the Rent to be Applied to the general use of the Family after paying Expenses there may probably be some debts and other charges to pay if so there is some things remaining that may not be paid out by me that will be sold and the amount used to discharge Negroes pay out all my debts and dues the Balance if any to be divided Equally among my five above named Children and Nancy Rumbly.

Should my New river Land be sold At any time did my Beaur is for my three Daughters to have Each of them Two Hundred Dollars to make their Negros equal to my two sons and what ever balance there might be to be Equally Divided between Thomas, Anson, Rebecca, Thresa, Polly and their Mother if sold in her life time.

My Beaur is that my wife should have Major to ride and one small Negro boy or girl to wait on her in the same way as those mentioned to her above.

I hereby Appoint as my Executors to this my Last Will and Testament Thomas & Anson Chadwick In witness whereof I have hereunto set my Hand & Seal this Eighteenth Day of July 1828

July 1828 Then was also annexed written paper exhibited into open Court & alio not witnessed was duly proved by the oaths of Oliver Chadwick, Ambrose James, & Anson Haverlock et al. witnesses who swear that they were well acquainted with the hand writing of this testator and that they believed the said Will and every part thereof to be in the proper hand writing of the said Samuel Chadwick whom upon the same was admitted to probate and Thomas Chadwick & Anson Chadwick the Executors therein named qualified as such and after Testamentary ordered to issue
