perfect mind & memory blessed be God do this last day of April
the Year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty
publish this my last will and testament in the manner
following that is to say. first I give and bequeath unto my
my wife Anne Willis all the property belonging to me during her
natural life then after her death to be divided in the following

manor, to my son Alphonse Willis I give the lot where he lives
the balance of the land placed to be divided equally between my sons
James & Isaac & also the enclosure to be divided between Abraham
Willis & Isaac Willis first I give unto my son
Abraham Willis the piece joining my son Alphonse home to the piece
with lands to my daughter Nancy I give the next adjoining des-
cending to the tract which the remainder of the plantation with houses
my son Isaac Willis the out land my wife and desire is that
James be in his equal parts to my son Simon Isaac Alphonse
Abraham & Isaac Willis in like manner my wife and
desire is that the Household furniture to be equally divided amongst
my children my desire is that my Cattle be equally divided
amongst all my children and I hereby ordain my two worthy
sons Simon Willis & Isaac Willis executrix to this my last will and
testament - I am writing whereof I the said Seth Willis do make
my last will and testament - hereunto I set my hand & seal
this day & year above written sigma sealed published & declared
the said Seth Willis testator as his last will & testament in
