I Solomon White Davis of Carteret County, being very sick but in perfect mind & memory being mindful of Mortality & for the Inconstancy of my family do make my last Will and Testament; in form & manner following Cheif of all I command, my soul to be eted good & through the Merit of Jesus Christ my Remander & my body to the Earth to be decently bur at the Discretion of my of my Executors here after mentioned & as for much Worlly Woods as land I have pleased to Bless me with I dispose of them as follows after paying all my just debts

First - of all I leave to well beloved wife Jan Davis the Plantation; Where I now live with all the land lying on the West side of the Mill Branch beginning at the mouth of Mill Branches & running due south to the other line & along the line to the Westward it do Run & Runing Straight from thence to a Creek standing up on the back yard hill and from thence to the mouth of the Mill Branch for her comfort & support - Until my son Nathan Davis comes to the age of twenty years old; & then to be divided and for my wife to have one Half of the said Land in her natural life I also leave to my well beloved wife three Negroes called - Will - Simon & Thorough and one Half of all my house old Goods furniture & half of my plantation tools and three cows and calfs half of my Hogs and a Mair Called Tilla for her comfort & support in during her natural life

I also give and bequeath to my son Longin Davis A plantation Lying on Sedor point Containing two hundred and twenty five acres to him and his heirs and Assigns for ever.

I also give to my son Samuel Davis and my son Erast Davis & Nathan Davis all the remainder part of the tract of land Where I now live on that is not all Ready sent to be Equally divided between them to their and ther heirs and Assigns for ever

I give and bequeath to my sons Anthony Davis a tract or parcel of Land & house Lying on the road near the lower hedge with all my Land

aguing descent to him and his heirs & Assigns for ever

I give and bequeath to my Nathan Davis one half of the Land I have left to my wife to be delivered to him when he com of age and for him to have the remainder of the Land at the death of his mother to him and his heirs and Assigns for ever -

I give & Request to my daughter Mary Day one Negro girl Liley and What she has all ready received and also if I give her Daughter Rebekah Day one yearling Steifer to her & her heirs & Assigns for ever.

I give and bequeath to my daughter Fannie Holly one Negro girl called Anna to her & her heirs and Assigns for her and I give her also three cows and calves & one Feeder Ryd & Furniture -

I give & Bequeath to my daughter Elency Davis one Negro boy by the name of Merica & three cows and calves & one Feeder Ryd & Furniture to her & her heirs & Assigns for ever -

I give and bequeath to my Daughter Relicy Davis one Negro boy Named Peter to her & her heirs & Assigns for ever & three Cows & Calves & one Feeder Ryd & Furniture -

I give and bequeath to my son Allen Davis one Negro boy by the name of frost to him and his heirs and Assigns for ever & I also sixty acres of Land lying on the North side of Mantle's Creek that I Purchased of Tyndall Howard to him & his heirs & Assigns for ever & and I also give my son Allen Davis one fourth part of my mills when he comes to the age of ten years old.

I give & bequeath unto my son Longin Davis one Negro boy & and like thise I give unto my son Leggin Davis & Anthony Davis one Negro boy by the name of Day to him & their heirs & Assigns for ever.

I give & bequeath to my son Samuel Davis one Negro man by the name of Sam to him & their heirs and Assigns for ever -

I also give & bequeath unto my sons Samuel Davis and Erast Davis & Nathan Davis & Allen Davis my mills and that my son Allen Comes to the age of ten years then take one fourth part of the said Mills & that my four sons shall all be Equally in Every Expence that shalbe in wanting in Building & Repairing & furnishing other Wanting

I give also to my four Sons & two Daughters Samuel Davis Emma Davis & Nathan Davis & Allen Davis & Elency Davis & Relcy Davis one Negro woman by the name of Till to be Equally Divided amongst them all their & their heirs

I also give & bequeath to my wife now all of which have a privilege of fishing on all my masters & slaves equally alike; and also it is my will & desire that my wife should have all her goods around Town free.

I give and bequeath to my son Edward Davis one house by the name of School to him & his heirs to enjoy.

I also give & bequeath to my four sons Samuel Davis, Edward Davis & Nathan Davis & Allen Davis with the mill three yds of stairs & carriage & all she-entertainment belong to the mill.

And it is my will & desire that all my lands & houses & stocks that I have not already given a to be sold publickly Vandue & also at the death my wife all that I lent her to be Equally Divided Between my sons by Davis & Samuel Davis & Edward Davis & Nathan Davis, Anthony Davis & Allen Davis & Turner Wiley & Clayton & Betsey Davis.

I also constitute and appoint my son Lazarus Davis & Samuel Davis Executors of this my last-will & Testament Revoking all other former Wills made by me at any time before made and acknowledged to be my last will and testament in Witness hereof I have set my hand and seal this twentieth day of February 1794

In the Name of God amen I Christopher Dudley of Craven County Being weak in Body but of sound memory Being mind full of Mortality and for the benefit of my family do more than my last will and testament in form following in chief of all I command my sole to God but for it was through the merit of Jesus Christ my Redeemer and my Body to the Earth to be decently Buried at the Discretion of my Executors hereafter mentioned and for such worldly losses as God hath been pleased to afflict me wish I Dispose of as followeth.

First of all I Give to my three sons Elijah, Christopher & Abraham Dudley one tract and plantation of land containing two hundred and fifty acres on the Black Swamp on the East side of White Oak River the manor plantation I now own Likewise it is my desire that if of either of my above mentioned Sons he inherit a Lawful Estate Begotten of his natural Bodies it is to be Divided between th- older two or the longest line of said Sons coming to age to share and their Lawfully Begotten of their Bodies for ever.

Also I Give to my three Sons Elijah, Christopher & Abraham Dudley all my carpenters Joiners Copers & Shunmakers Tools to be Equally Divided amongst my three Sons at the Electing of age to them and their Heirs for ever.

Also I Give to my son Elijah two cows anno Earling to him and his Heirs for ever also I Give to my son Christopher two cows to him and his Heirs for ever also I Give to my son Abraham one cow to him and his Heirs for ever.

also I Give to my Daughter Delilah one feather bed one Cow and two Heifers to her and her Heirs for ever

I also Give to my Daughter Lucy one Cow and Heifer and one feather bed to her and her Heirs for ever

also Give to Daughter Rachel one Cow and one feather bed to her and her Heirs for ever

also I send to my beloved wife Susannah Dudley all the Rest of my estate that not will excepting a Whippoor-Willow tree two Lams and my part of the land marsh living his widow Hood such as Plantation tools horses cattle Hogs and Sheep Likewise one Negro man and household furniture to bring up my children with proper Learning at the Discretion of my Executors and Likewise at my Desire that after my beloved wife Death or marriage to be Equally Divided Between my three Sons and the Daughters to a sum and their Heirs and assigns for ever. I also desire that my Executors sign a Deed to John Stankey for my
