5th day of February in the year of our Lord 1813 made
published this my last will and Testament in manner
following (that is to say) First I give to my daughter
Sabra Hydon during her natural life two acres of Land
whereon her Dwelling House now stands, and assign to
Decree to her son Solomon Hydon his Stein and
Assigns forever Also I then give to my daughter Susanna
Dixon all the rest of my Estate both real and personal
which I may then possessed of, to live and support herself
upon making no waste during her natural life
and after her Decease, I then give & bequeath to my son
George Washington Dixon (the son of Caleb Dixon
my son) Fifty acres of Land out of my purchase from
Benjamin Wilson taking in my mansion House and
Improvements where I now live - also a Bay mare
rising to the southward) a Cow & Calf, and the first
female child my Negro Girl Rose shall be delivered
and further after the Decesse of my wife the rest of my
Estate then left - both real & personal I will & bequeath
that it be equally Divided amongst all my Children
living and the Heirs or representatives of those deceased
share and share alike as though they were all living -
that is the Children of each deceased Child of my sons
to have their Deceased parents share amongst them but
George W. Dixon whose legacy is given him as aforesaid
And I make and ordain my sons Solomon Dixon &
William C. Dixon my Executors of this my last will
and Testament. In witness whereof I the said Richd
Dixon have hereunto set my hand and Seal, the day and
Year above written.

I Susanna Davis, being weak in body but sound in mind & perfect
in memory, do make & declare this my last will & testament; first I
give & bequeath unto my daughter Sarah Davis to have & her heirs
for ever the article (viz) one chare of drams or its value in money, her
choice one of my feather beds, one blue bed quilt; one old quilt or
blanket and two sheets, bolster and two pillows, one pot, one Spiced
pot, one Tea kettle, one camp kettle, one pair of fire irons, Two cows
& Calves of her first choice, all of my cotton - Three chairs, one chest,
and the half of one other Cow Callie beauty together with all her increase
& the increase of all the before mentioned ones. Secondly I give and
bequeath unto my grand son James S. Adams & his heirs for ever my
feather bed the one I usually lay on, one pair Counterpan, one blanket
one new Cover red, one bed spread, Two sheets one pot, Two cows
& Calves (Callie & his wife choice) one Mahogany Table, one chest, one
sheet, and all of my sheep, and Twenty dollars to be raised out of a
part of my other property, and given my Executors see the said Twenty
dollars be directed in the best advantage to his education, Thirdly
I give to my daughter Margaret Glanton ten dollars, Fourthly I
give to my daughter Anna Freeman one two year old heifer.
Fifthly I give to my daughter Esther Adams one cow & calf, one Copper
pot. Sixthly I give to my grand daughter Elizabeth Mary Allen
one Heifer. Seventhly I give to my daughter Rhoda Mae one
Counterpan, one blanket & one sheet; Eighthly I give to my son
Enoch my feather bed which I have myself previously given away.
Ninthly I give to my friend Jesse Weathering one cow & heifer
and her increase to come forever. Tenthly all the remainder of
my property not above mentioned I leave to be sold to the best advo-
cate and all the moneys arising from such sale my debt first to
be paid the balance to be equally divided between my four
daughter (viz) Mary, Esther, Rhoda and Sarah. Lastly I appoint
my son Enoch Davis with my friend Francis More to be Executors to
the my last will. Signed Sealed and dated the day and year
