tation with all of my land her lifetime.

I give and bequeath unto my daughter Anna
or her heirs four shillings to be paid by my executors at my
decease

I Give and Bequeath unto my son Joseph Gillis or his
heirs four shillings to be paid by my executors at my decease

I Give and bequeath unto my son Ammon Gillis
or his heirs to be paid by my executors at my decease five
shillings.

I Give and Bequeath unto my Daughter
Rhode four shillings to be paid by my executors at my
decease. I Give and bequeath to my Grandson
Jesse Gillis his heifore and this increase by this
mane over slope the right ere

I Give and Bequeath unto my son Ammon Gillis
or his heirs four shillings to be paid by my executors
at my decease

I Give and bequeath unto three of my children here named
my Daughter Zilpha and my Daughter Loris and my son
Wright Gillis which three named I Give and bequeath
all of my movable property which I have will away
at the decease of my wife there is one hundred and fifty-
acres of land which I purpose of selling of if not sold
before my decease the land that is called the far ridge
which land is to be sold at auction and my wife to have
the money for it these three children here named my
Daughter Zilpha and my Daughter Loris and my son Wright
Gillis which Property here named I Give and bequeath
unto them and their heirs for ever to be equally divided
among them three here named and their heirs to have
and to hold in quiet possession this my last will
and testament lastly I Do make and ordain Wright
Gillis and Thomas Russell to be my executors

January One thousand and Eight hundred and

 my sons William and David my Executors to this my last
 will and Testament and in witness hereof I have set
 my hand and seal this 5th day of August 1813
