one cow and all the rest of my estate in doors and out
doors goods and Chattels rite and Credits I give to my
son Thomas Goodwin at my Decease.

Eighthly and Lastly I do Nomynate constitute appoint
and Or claim my son Thomas Goodwin and my brother
Allen Robinson Executors to this my Last will and
testament Signed Sealed and published this Seventh
day of August one thousand Seven hundred and
Ninety two in the presence of us.

be divided into Four Lots from front to back to the
North Bay giving my son Oliver Goodwin and his heirs and
old fields and all the land from there to Swan Point and
fifty acres of Land lying on the South west side of the North
Bay marsh Fifthly I give and bequeath to my Daughtler
Sarah Goodwin one cow and half and Forty Dollars in
Money Sixthly I give and bequeath to my Daughtler Emily
Goodwin one Saddle Bed Four Cows and Lamb Seventhly
I give and bequeath to my son Wright Goodwin and his
heirs the Lot of Land whereon Aaron Hyson now lives
a hundred and sixty acres of marsh joining the North
Creek Twenty five acres of Land lying on the South west
side of the Gum Swamp and one cow and half Eightly
I give and bequeath to my Daughtler Hannah Goodwin one
young Steep Ninthly I give and bequeath to my son
Thomas Goodwin Two Cows and Lamb Tenthly I
give and bequeath to my son Joseph Goodwin and his
heirs the Lot of Land lying at the corner of the Bay Twenty
five acres of Land lying on the South west side of the
Gum Swamp and one young mare Eleventhly I give
and bequeath to my son Jesse Goodwin one young
Horse and three years schooling before he is of age
Twelfthly and lastly I leave to my wife Recha Good-
win the Plantation whereon I now live taking part of
the Woods above and below it Fifty acres of Land lying
on the South west side of the North Bay marsh during
her life time and afterwards to pass to my son Thomas
Goodwin and his heirs I leave to my wife Recha Goodwin
one negro Boy named Curry her life time and then to
fall to my son Oliver Goodwin and his heirs I
Leave to my wife Recha Goodwin all the rest of my

worldly goods and battle her life time and then
to be equally divided amongst all my children
I do nominate constitute appoint and ordain
Shadrigh Emery Thomas Robinson and my
son Oliver Goodwin to be Executors to this
my last Will and Testament

County and State of North Carolina, being weak of body, but of
sound mind and ^{memory} ~~memory~~ do this thirteenth day of June in the
year of our Lord 1807, make and ordain this my last will
and Testament in manner following, that is to say.

After paying all my just debts I leave unto my
wife Zilpha Gabriel for her and my childrens support
during her natural life, all my Estate both Real and Per-
sonal, and desire her to keep our Children with her and
take care of them until she and they see cause and they
can provide better for themselves. Two acres of Land
whereon the House of Charles Gillispie stands only
excepted, which two acres of Land I give and devise
unto him the said Charles Gillispie, his heirs and assigns
for ever.

And at my said wifes decease all the Remainder of my
Land to be equally divided among all my sons that may
be then living and the legal Representatives of any that
may be then dead, that is for all the Representatives
of my deceased son to have the same share their parent would
be entitled to if living. To them and their heirs and assigns for ever.

And all my Personal Property at my said wifes
decease that may be then remaining I give and bequeath to
be equally divided among all my Daughters that may be then
living, and the legal Representatives of any that may be then
dead, that is for all the Representatives of my deceased Daugh-
ters to have the same share their parent would be entitled
to if living. To them and their heirs and assigns for ever.

And Lastly I appoint my said wife Zilpha to
Execute this my last will and Testament. In witness whereof
I the said Benjamin Gabriel have hereunto set my hand and
