

In the name of God amon December the 2^d of December 1792
 I Thomas Goulding of Bartol County North Carolina, being very sick and low in Body but of perfect mind and memory and belling to mind the mortality of my Body knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die do make and ordain this my Last will and Testament, that is to say first of all I give my Soul into the hands of God that gives it and my Body to the Earth to be Buried in a Christian like manner at the discretion of my Executors nothing daunting But I shall Receive it a gain by the mighty power of god and as touching such worldly goods or estate as it has pleased god to Indue me with as followeth.

Item I give and bequeath unto my well beloved wife one hundred acres of Land a where I now live during her life her widowhood and afterwards to my son John Goulding.

Item I Give and bequeath unto my son Thomas Goulding fifty acres of Land a where he now Lives.

Item I give and bequeath unto my son Elannel Goulding fifty acres of Land on the west side of Long Bay on the north side of the neck.

Item I Give to my Daughter Sarah Goulding one hundred acres of Land beginning at the Little But to the eastward.

Item I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Elizabeth Smith fifty acres of Land where she now Lives.

Item I Give and bequeath unto my son George Goulding and David Goulding all my Land in bounding need to be Equally divided between them.

Item I give and bequeath unto George and David Goulding likewise twenty five acres a piece in the piece of swamp to the Eastward of Thomas Goulding.

Item I give and bequeath unto my daughter Mary Goulding twenty five acres in the swamp and fifty acres of pine Land.

Item I Give and bequeath unto my son Elannel Goulding fifty acres Laying on Both sides of the neck beginning at the Little gut to the Eastward and fifty acres of pine Land in the neck.

Item I give and bequeath unto my son Thomas Goulding fifty acres of pine Land in the neck.

Item I give and bequeath unto my well beloved wife all my moveable Estate during her life her widowhood.

Item I Give and bequeath unto my sons George and David Goulding one hundred acres of Land at the Ridge of Oaks between them.

Item I Give and bequeath all the Rest of my pine Land and

more, unto three sons Elannel, Thomas and John Goulding to be Equally divided between them.

Item I furthermore nominate make and ordain and appoint my well beloved wife Elizabeth Goulding Elannel Goulding and Thomas Goulding my sole Executors to this my Last will and Testament.
