Adham Garner, I do give one Shilling Specie each, also I give to my
nephew Polly Chidam one Shilling Specie each also to my daughter
Mary I do give one Shilling bed, all of my other property of every
kind and nature which is not mentioned in this will I do leave to be
settled public sale by my Executors and all of my just debts to be paid
at the same and what a life after the debts is paid to be equally divided
among my children except William & Adham and my daughter
Mary Chidam to whom I have given one Shilling each to be paid them
by my Executors with full legacy of my estate and I hereby declare
the above to be my last will and testament & disallow & make
void all other wills or writings whatever to this effect Moreover
I hereby ordain constitute and appoint my son David Garner
my sole Executor to this my last will and testament to execute and
discharge according to the meaning & intent thereof without-
terior or any manner of alteration, whatever in testimony
whereof I the said William Garner do hereunto set my hand
this 31st of December in the year of our Lord one
thousand eight hundred & twenty nine

I the undersigned make and publish this my last will and testament as follows to wit first as touching the words will My will & desire is to be decently buried by my executors here mentioned and I desire to commit my soul to almighty god when I am dead touching my worldly goods which god hath blessed me with namely Watson after all my just debts first being paid by my executors Item I leave unto my beloved wife during of her natural life March term 1803 was then exhibited unto open Court and duly proved before me all of my house hold and kitchen furniture plants tools and all of my Stock of horses, cattle, hogs, sheep, and every thing contained in this last will and testament of Gashaw Adams, thing or things of every kind or nature whatsoever I know, my law & desire is after my wife Scamy debt or marriage settled for the property before mentioned to be sold by my executors and the money or note to be equally divided between my wife Sarah Addams seven daughters, Sarah Bell, Nancy Addams, Anna Addams, Sarah Addams, Eliza Addams, Sidney Addams, Naomi Addams & in case either one of the seven should die without heirs of her body then for that one part to be equally divided among myself Sidney Addams surviving daughters to them heirs and apiece for ever I item I give and bequeath unto my daughter Anna to Elizabeth Stepan in the sum of one hundred dollars & half lot in Beaufort one feather bed and a pair of sheets to the payment whereof will and truly to be furnished one Cow & Calf to her and her heirs and apiece for made to the said Elizabeth Stepan executors & Administrators and this is deemed to be her part of my property she hath also apiece for mine own heirs executors & Administrators had, I item I give and bequeath unto my daughter Rebecca half & severally to her by these presents shall be the other half of her in Beaufort & being the other half of her estate than \$200 day of June A.D. 1803 I gave Elizabeth Davis also I give our feather bed & furniture

our Cow & Calf to her two heirs and apiece for ever which property she hath all ready Received I item I give and bequeath to Elizah Adams wife Addams William Adams John Adams four sons all of my sons that they hold by blood all ready which I nominate my beloved Sons William Adams and my son John & Rose my executors to this my last will and testament overlooking all other wills by me before made in testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal this 30 day of September
