

In the Name of God Amen, I Jacob Bell of Eastern County
in the State of North Carolina being of Sound and perfect mind
and Memory, blessed be God, do this first day of April
in the Year of our Lord One Thousand Eight hundred and
Eleven, Make and Publish this my Last Will and Testament
in manner following that is to say, first, that all my just and
Lawful debts be paid as hereafter Directed.

Item, I give unto my son Jacob Bell that part of my Land Joining
Black Creek, being the Easternmost part, beginning at James
Winigths Corner formerly a pine, but now a Stake, thence
running a Westerly Course half way to Carters Branch, thence
running a Northerly Course to the back line of said patent as to
indistinct the back part of the same to be as wide as the front, thence
Easterly along the back line of the patent to Black Creek thence
down the various Courses of the said Creek to the beginning, the
above mentioned land and of and bounded as aforesaid, I give
and bequeath unto my said son Jacob Bell his paying and
third part of all my debts to him and to his Heirs and Assigns
for ever.

I give unto my son Joseph Cole Bell that part of my Land
Joining Borden's Land, being the Westernmost part of my Land
I now live on, beginning at the mouth of the branch where
my Negro James Cleared a small piece of ground, thence
running up the various Courses of said Branch to the fork,
thence running up the same Course of Borden's Land to the
back line of my said patent, thence Westerly along the back
of my said patent to the Corner, thence running down along Borden's
line one mile, thence to the beginning, the above mentioned
Land and of and Bounded as aforesaid, I give and bequeath unto
my said son Joseph Cole Bell his paying One third part of all my
debts to him and to his Heirs and Assigns for ever.

I give unto my son Caleb Hous Bell that part of my Land
I now live on, beginning at the mouth of the branch where
my Negro James Cleared a small piece of ground at my sons
Joseph's trees beginning Borden, thence running Easterly
along the back of said patent to the mouth of Carters Branch
thence running up the middle of said Branch to the back
line of my said patent, thence Westerly along the line to
my son Joseph's Bell back Corner, thence down his line

led to the beginning including my House and Plantation
where I now live, the above mentioned land laid off and bounded

as a fore said I give and bequeath unto my said son Caleb Norris
Bills his paying one third part of all my Debt to him and to
his Heirs and Assigns for ever

Item I give unto my two Daughters Charlotte Chadwick and
Elizabeth Rice, that part of my Land lying and being between
my son Jacob, part and my son Caleb Norris, part that I have
given them. the above mentioned Land I give and bequeath
unto my two said Daughters Charlotte and Elizabeth to them
and to their Heirs and Assigns for ever.

Item I give and bequeath unto my three sons Jacob Rice, Joseph
Cole Rice, and Caleb Norris Rice my two hundred acres of land
lying near the head of Deep Creek called the land of Cypress
they pay all my just Debts to them and to their Heirs and
Assigns for ever.

Item I give unto my son William Rice all my Blacksmith Tools
and I have paid for some Land he has now possession of.

Item I give unto my Grandson Caleb Rice the son of my son William
Rice One heffer and that my son William Charge the same.

Item I give unto my Daughter Abigail Chadwick Ten Dollars to be
raised out of my property, I have given already a great Deal of
timber unto my son in law Solomon Chadwick.

Item my Desire is that my Daughter Charlotte have all the Cattle
called here now in her name

Item I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Elizabeth Rice Cattle
and Furniture, One Cow called here one teaming wheel, loom
and gear.

Item I give unto my three sons Jacob Rice Joseph Cole Rice and
Noble Rice my Timber

my three said sons Jacob, Joseph Cole and Caleb Norris two
Shears and two Bulls for Oxen. my will and Desire is that
my Large Conew and Sail, my Saddle and iron horse
my Cattle not before given to be sold by my Executors to pay
my Debt, my wish is, the Timber and plank that I
got for Mr. Ward and Mr. Stanton that they may have it
in answering them and my Desire is that my property
not before given be sold by my Executors to pay my Debts
lastly my will and Desire is that my Executors Receive all

all the debts due to me and pay all my just and Lawful
Debt as aforesaid, and I make and Ordain my Son Jacob
Bell, my Son Joseph Cabel Bell and my Son Caleb Norris
Bell Executors of and to this my last will and Testament
In Witness whereof I the said Caleb Bell have hereunto
set my hand and Seal the Year and day above Written

Declared by the said Caleb Bell
the Testator as his last will
and Testament in the presence
of us.
