Ever all do one small Colt to him and heirs for Ever—
all do my father Beds and Furniture to him the said
Hancock and his heirs for Ever—

I Give and Bequeath unto my Grand son John Adams
the sum of five pounds current money of the State to
be paid to him at his coming of full age my Executor—

I Give and Bequeath unto my Grand son John Jones
the sum of five pounds current money to be paid by
my Executor at his coming of 21 years of age—

And I leave by Make and Ordain my friend
John Hancock Sen^r the Executor to this my Last
will and testament In witness whereof I the said

John Adams have to this my Last will and testament
At my hand and seal the day and year first above
written Signed sealed and delivered J. Adams
