Estate of Nathan Adams

In the name of God Amen I Nathan Addams being of
Strong mind and memory but weak in body and
Calling to mind that is appointed once called to
Die I Nathan Addams of the County of Carteret and
State of North Carolina I then do make this my last will
and testament as followeth to wit first at my last will
I desire is to be decently buried by my Executors
here in after mentioned and I desire to commit my Soul to
allmighty God who first gave it I know Tucking my
worldly goods which God hath blessed me with after all of
my just debts first being paid by my Executors
I leave I leave unto my beloved wife Susannah of her nature
at life or widowhood all of my house hold and kitchen
Furniture plantation tools and all of my Stock of horses
Cattle hogs Sheep and Every other thing or things of any
kind or nature what so ever I leave my will & Desire is
after my wife Susannah death or Marriage then for the
property before mentioned to be sold by my Executors and
the monies or moneys to be Equally divided between my
wife Susannah Addams Seven Daughters Mariah B. B.
Vancey Addams Anna Addams Sarah Addams Eliza
Addams Susannah Addams Naomi Addams and in if
either one of the Seven should die without heirs of their
body then for that ones part to be Equally divided a
mong my wife Susannah Addams Surviving Daughters
to their heirs and assigns for Ever I leave and be-
queath unto my daughter Elizabeth Davis one half
lot in beaufort one feather bed and furniture one cow
and calf to her heirs and assigns for Ever and this
is deemed to be her part of my property she hath all Raddy
had I leave and bequeath unto my Daughter Rebecca
Saberton the other half of lot in beaufort and the
other half of lot that I gave Elizabeth Davis affe's
give one feather bed and furniture and one cow and calf
to her heirs and assigns for Ever which said prop-
erty she hath all Raddy Received I leave and
bequeath unto Elizabeth Addams Joseph Addams William
Addams John Addams my four Sons all
Turn over

of my Lands that they hold by deed at Ready
and lastly I nominate my beloved sons William
Adams and my Son in Law John O'ell my
Executors to this my last will and Testament and
Revoking all other ^{wills} by me here to fore made in
Testimony hereof I have hereunto set my hand and
Seal this twentieth day of September in year of our Lord
one thousand Eight Hundred and Twenty four
