Know all men by these presents that we James Sanders Cornelius Dabney and Samuel Henderson all of the County of Caswell and State of North Carolina are held and firmly bound unto his Excellency Rich^d Dobbs Spaight esquire Governor &c in the sum and full sum of Twelve Hundred Pounds To be paid to the said Rich^d D. Spaight esquire and his successors in office and Assigns To the which payment is well and truly to be made we bind ourselves our Heirs Exors Adors &c Legally & honestly firmly by these presents Sealed with our seals and Dated this 30th day of January a Domb 1794.

The Condition of this Obligation is such that Whereas the above bounden James Sanders is by Law appointed to collect the public Taxes in the County of Caswell for the year 1793. If therefore the said James Sanders shall well and truly collect Account for and pay into the public Treasury of this State the public Taxes assessed on the Inhabitants of said County also the County Taxes and the Tax assessed for the Support of the poor in the County aforesaid to the County Trustees and the County Wardens and Treasurer of the said at such times and in such manner as the law direct without fraud or further delay Then the above Obligation shall be void otherwise to remain in full force & effect
