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In the name of God Amen, I Archibald Carlos of Caswell
County State of North Carolina, being in a weak state of
Health but of sound mind and memory, Thanks be to God
Do make & Ordain This my Last will & Testament, in form
following, In the first place, I recommend my soul to God
who gave it, And my body to be decently buried at
The Discretion of my Executors —

I Give The Land and plantation whereon I now Live
Containing 252 Acres purchased of Peter Smith & John
Coxwell, And to my wife Fanny Carlos during her
natural Life, & after her Death I give it to my son W^m
Carlos Carlos to him & his heirs & assigns forever. —

Item, As all my children that are married & gone off from
me have already had their parts, & Proportion of the
small estate I was possessed of, of which I do give to them
& their heirs & assigns — Item I give to my Daughter

Nancy one Negro Boy called Peyton, & one Negro
Girl called Molly, & a better bed & furniture to her
& her & him & assigns — Item the rest & residue of my

Estate, be it of what nature or kind so ever, I Leave
unto my wife Fanny Carlos, with this restriction to
give the said estate to any of her Children (that is to
say) Polly Dixon, William C. Carlos Polly
Robert Cook Carlos, Elizabeth Norman, & Nancy
Carlos, to them & their heirs forever. I Leave my wife

Fanny Carlos Executrix of this my Last will & Testament
In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this
