 Hundred Make & Ordain this my last Will & Testament in Manner
 & form following That is to say First, I bequeath to my beloved Wife Mary
 Egan four Negroes namely, Harry, Jimmy, Betty, and Lucy to hold to
 her during her life or Widowhood and after the decease I devise the same
 to my Son William Wilson Egan to hold to him his heirs & assigns forever
 Also I give & bequeath to my Daughter Mary I Harris two Negroes namely
 Edward & Viney, also one Feather Bed & Furniture, to hold to her heirs and
 assigns forever - Also I give and bequeath to my Daughter Phoebe
 Egan two Negroes namely Lewis & John - Also one Feather Bed & Furniture
 to hold to her her heirs & assigns forever - Also I give and bequeath
 to my Daughter Nancy Egan two Negroes namely Leah & Ned -
 also one feather Bed and Furniture - to hold to her her heirs and assigns
 forever - And all the Land belonging to me lying and being in the
 County of Carroll State of Maryland, together with the slave thereon it is
 my Will and Desire that the whole may be sold and the Money arising
 from the Sale of said Land to be appropriated to the payment of my
 Debts and the Balance remaining (if any should be) after paying my
 Debts to be given to my son William Wilson Egan as soon as he shall arrive
 to majority or until he is twenty years of age or shall be for Schooling & other
 necessary Expenses, and all my stock of Horses, cattle, Hogs & together with
 the Furniture of the Household and Kitchen Furniture to remain in the
 hands of my Wife Mary Egan during her life or Widowhood and after her decease
 the same to be divided equally among all the Children, I make & Ordain my
 beloved Son William Egan, my Son in Law Capt. Robert H. Egan as Executors
 to this my last Will and Testament to take have & sell the same perform
 according to the full Intent & Meaning of this my last Will and Testament
 In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & the Day and year as
 written
