and a Legatee of my late Husband Henry Dixon Curand
for Services done and performed in the last American War
in any other manner, and further to do and execute all and
every such acts and things, tending to the recovery of any estate
and Right as aforesaid. Either real or personal and to give
discharge for the same — and further I do hereby give and
grant unto my said Attorney full and whole power and
Authority in my Name, place and place to make and conclude
with any Person or Persons any Agreement whatever touching
the premises with full power and Authority to convey and
transfe the same in as full and ample a Manner as I
myself could do in my own person to the best prober
use and benefit of the said Nathaniel Williams Esq. my
