This Indenture made this 21st day of Decem^r Anno Domⁱ 1792.
Between Thomas Rice servant in behalf of his fellow Justices of the County
Court of Caswell and their Successors of the one part and Robert
William of the other part Witnesseth that the said Thomas Rice upon
in pursuance to an Order of our County Court of Caswell made
the 21st day of December Anno Domⁱ 1792 and agreeable to the
Direction of the Act of our General Assembly in that case
made and provided hath put place and bind unto the said Robert William
David Hall an Orphan being of the age of fifteen years and ten
Months, until he shall attain to the age of Twenty one year
causing at which time his said Master he hath duly shall serve
his said Master's Commands wherever gladly being he shall not at
any time absent himself from his said Master's service
but in all things as a Good and faithful servant shall
behave towards his said Master. And the said Robert William
doth Covenant Promise and agree to and with the said Thomas
Rice that he will teach and instruct or cause to be taught
and instructed. The said David Hall to read Write &c. also
the Art and Mystery of a Blacksmith and that he will
Constantly find and provide for the said child or children
sufficient diet washing Lodging and Apparel fitting for
an Apprentice and Servant and also all other things
necessary both in Clothing and in Health. In Witness whereof
the Parties to these presents hath interchangedly set their hands &
affixt their seals the day and year first above written.

of Caswell and State of North Carolina for and in consideration of the
late Legacy of my wife Elizabeth Boulton late Elizabeth Farley
Orphan and Daughter of Moses Farley Dec^d being dead Negroes &c.
to me in hand paid & and before the sealing and delivering of these
presents the Receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge by Samuel
Johnston late Guardian to my said Wife Elizabeth and myself here-
with fully satisfied and contented and for other good causes and consid-
eration me hereunto moving. I the said Charles Boulton late have released
released and forever quit claim and by these presents do remise, release
and forever quit claim unto the said Samuel Johnston late Guardian to
his said Wife's Estate all and all manner of Actions and Actions
Cause and causes of Actions Suits, Bills, Bonds, writings and Obligatory
Debts and accounts sums and sums of Money Judgments, Executions
Quarrels, Expenses, Damages and Demands whatsoever and also
all and every Legacy & Legacy to me belonging of the Estate of
Moses Farley and Joseph Farley Dec^d and all other claims &
demands whatsoever within in Law or Equity, or otherwise howsoever
which against the said Samuel Johnston late Guardian for the said
Elizabeth I ever had or now have. And which my said Wife or
Administrators shall or may hereafter claim challenge or Demand
for or against him the said Samuel Johnston his said Wife's Estate
for or by recovery of any Legacy or Legacy fallen to my said Wife
Elizabeth from the estate of the said Moses Farley Joseph Farley
Dec^d or given or bequeathed in the last Will and Testament of the
said Moses Farley Dec^d or for any matter cause or thing
whatsoever from the beginning of the world to the day of the date
of these presents In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand
and seal the 21st day of November in the seven tenth year of
our Independence & Domⁱ 1792.
