Know all men by these presents that I David Enochs do hereby authorize and empower Clifton Allen as my attorney to seal and deliver unto Thomas Graves Sen^r his Heirs &c a good and Lawfull Quo of Conveyance for one Hundred Eighty and a quarter Acre of Land Lying on the Waters of Country Creek adjoining the Lands of Thomas Yancy, Thomas Graves and David Enochs, part of a tract known by the name of Kelley's Land, and I do hereby Oblige myself my Heirs &c to abide by whatsoever be the said Clifton Allen as my Attorney may do as done myself were I present, and to stand Good and Law in all things touching the same at my hand and seal this 4th day of September, 1796
