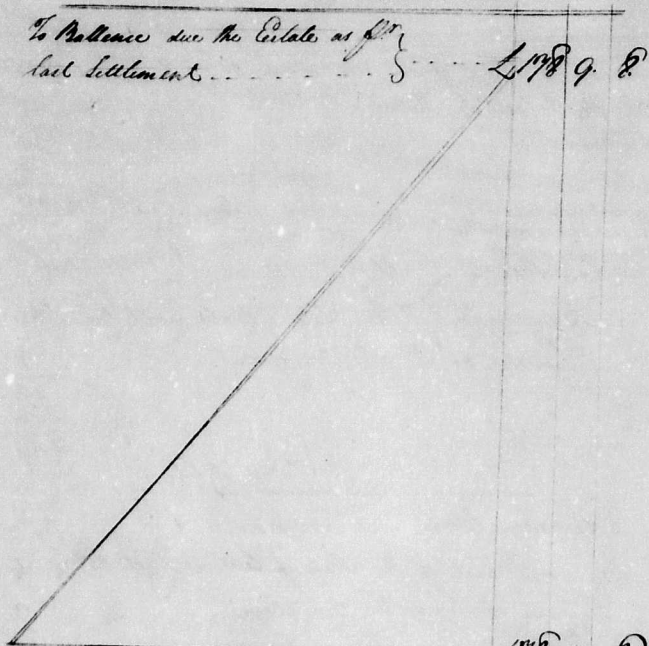

Sealed with my seal and Dated this Thirtieth day of Jan^y 1789 -

The condition of the above obligation is such, that if the above bounden David Hart his heirs Executors Administrators or assigns shall well & truly make or cause to be made to the above said George Sims his heirs or assigns a good and Lawful Deed to Elizabeth and Twenty three Acres of Land. Including the plantation whereon the said Sims now lives and bounded as follows, to wit: Beginning at a white oak corner of Oliver Daniels recovery North 10 Degrees East 190 poles to a white oak near Turkeypen Branch. Thence North 40 Degrees East 74 poles to a box oak or Hart's path thence East 152 poles to a box oak on Gantts Line.
