Know all men by these presents that I George Reed of the County of Canada and State of North Carolina, hath this day bargained, sold and Delivered unto Jesse Carter of Caswell County and State of North Carolina One small Lord Mares with a Star in her forehead, Two Spots and One Dutch Oven, Two Kewes and Calves a black and white spotted, and one Red Brindle, Two Cotton Whels, One Black Walnut Table, One good pine Chest half doz plates and two Dishes, One Hoghead Tobacco, Three Beds and furniture for the consideration of Thirty pounds Virginia Currency to him in hand paid by the said Jesse Carter, for which I bind myself my heirs Executors & Administrators a speiss against the claim or Claims of every person or persons whatsoever to the only proper use of the said Jesse Carter his heirs Executors or Administrators In Witness whereof I Seal this Twenty second day of January One Thousand seven hundred Ninety five

Know all men by these presents that we Hugh Dobbin and Thomas Jeffreys of Caswell County and State of North Carolina are and shall jointly and severally bind our heirs and assigns unto Robert Taylor of the said County and State in the full sum of seven hundred and seventy nine pounds Current money, To the which payment is due and truly to be made we bind ourselves our heirs Executors and Assigns and each of them jointly & severally jointly by these presents sealed with our Seals and Dated this fourth day of February One Thousand Seven Hundred Ninety five.

The Condition of this Obligation is such that Whereas the above bound Hugh Dobbin hath the day of the date of these presents Executed a Deed to the said Robert Taylor for two hundred and thirty four and a half acres and also any other pieces of land lying for one hundred and fifty acres of Land lying and being in the County of Caswell on the North side of Helgus Branch and bounded as follows: Beginning at a white Oak a corner of Abner Dunaway's on Helgus Branch thence along the road to John Hall's Corner thence West along John Hall's line fifty nine chains to a white Oak said Hall and Archibald Semple's Corner thence South sixty nine Chains to a point on Helgus Branch thence the measure of the said Branch up to the Beginning.

If Therefore the said Hugh Dobbin shall forever support maintain and defend the title of the said Land free from all Incumbrances either of claims, Confections, Judgments, Prebts, Judgments and Executions at any time heretofore had or at any time hereafter may come against the same without fraud or delay that then the above Obligation shall be void otherwise to remain in full force and effect.
