In the Name of God Amen This 11th day of September in the year of our Lord Jesus Christ seven hundred and ninety five I Isaac Beloe of the County of Carroll and State of North Carolina being in perfect health and of sound mind and memory do make and declare this my last Will and Testament in the following manner and form. I hereby bequeath that all my just Debt be lawfully paid by my Executors hereafter named. Then I Give unto my Daughter Emma Harrell five Shillings and no more. She being married to one hundred acres of Land and some Stock in my lifetime. Then I Give unto my son Daniel Beloe forty acres of Land to be laid off by a North and South line and to lay down Samuel line. Then I Give to my Daughter Mary Beloe the remainder of my land supposed to be eight five rods (be the same more or less) in the plantation where I live also one Horse and Saddle and one Cow and yearling to her and her heirs forever. And after my just Debt are all paid I Order that my son Daniel Beloe shall have my shop tools and plantation tools. I also Order that my Daughter Mary Beloe shall have my household furniture at my death and whatsoever Stock shall be after my Daughter Mary's legacy as above. I Order that it be equally divided between my son Daniel and my Daughter Mary.

And I do hereby constitute and appoint my beloved Daughter Mary Beloe my Executor and my loving friend Stephen Langart my Executor to this my last Will and Testament. hereby requesting and making void all other Will or Wills by me made calling and confirming this only to be my last Will and Testament.
