I have all men by these presents that I Jane Pitts (Wilson) of the State of North Carolina am County of Rockingham for divers considerations and good cause now heretofore moving, have made, Ordained, Constituted and Appointed and by these presents do make Ordain and constitute John Price Esq. of State Attorney and County of Caswell, my true and lawful attorney for me in my name to make a lawful right, To all my lands of land belonging to me in and of the lands left by my Husband Edward Pitts at his Decease逝世, lying and being in the County of Caswell and State aforesaid, also to collect Demand, Murrat or due for, review and relief for and with the Executor to the estate of the above Edward Pitts Deceased all my claim or demands against said Estate; to make the right of the above Lands, to Thomas Arnett & his heirs during my life and to collect the above Money as if I myself might or could do were I personally present, and in my name all singular things or things which shall or may be necessary touching and concerning the said Land or collecting the said Money and receiving the same as fully thoughly and entirely as I the said Jane Pitts in my own person might or could do, in and about the same, Testifying, allowing, and confirming whatever my said Attorney shall lawfully do or cause to be done in and about the said Lands of claim by virtue of these presents, In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 11th day of March 1799 —
