- Item I Give and bequeath to my Daughter Elizabeth Thomas One Shilling Currency
- Item I Give and bequeath to my Daughter Agnes Hogg One Shilling Currency
- Item I Give and bequeath to my son Gideon Hogg One Shilling Currency
- Item I Give and bequeath to my Daughter Sarah Gideon one Shilling Currency
- Item I Give and bequeath to my Daughter Rebekah Nelson One Shilling Currency
- Item I Give and bequeath to my Daughter Mary Yates One Shilling Currency

Know all men by these presents that I James Yates of the County of Sumner in the Western Territory have for sundry good causes and weighty considerations have constituted and appointed, and by these presents do nominate and appoint and in my stead and place put my Trusty and well beloved Brother William Yates of the County of Caswell and State of North Carolina as my true and lawful Attorney to let Demand Levy Recover and receive for me and in my name and to my use and behoof of John Blackwell of Granville County the sum of Twenty four pounds Virginia hard money which the said Blackwell hath given his bond to me for under his hand & Seal bearing date a November the first 1792.
