Know all men by these presents that whereas I John James Farley of the County of Concord and State of North Carolina, did recover and obtain a Judgment, against John Lewis (M) for a sum of forty five pounds or to more that amount together with Costs, and whereas the said Lewis has removed himself and property to the State of Georgia some time before the aforesaid Judgment was obtained; I the said John James Farley, therefore, hereby nominate and constitute my attorney Seaborn Jones Esquire of the aforesaid State of Georgia my lawful Attorney in fact, as well as my Attorney at Law, to and for the intent and purpose of commencing a suit against the aforesaid John Lewis in the State of Georgia for the purpose of recovering and receiving for me and in my behalf, the aforesaid Judgment, together with all costs and Costs that he may at any time hereafter incur on the said recovery; And I do hereby instruct and charge the aforesaid Seaborn Jones as fully to do all and transact all and every part of the aforesaid business as to suing receiving, Receiving, Discharging and releasing him as I could do myself and I was at all times personally present at the transaction of every circumstance relating the premises aforesaid, in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 27th day of July 1797.
