This Indenture made the fourth Monday of October 1799 - between Robert Parks esq. Chairman for the County Court of Newell and State of North Carolina, in behalf of his fellow Justices of the said County of one part and James Sinclair of the other part Witnesseth that the said Robert Parks in pursuance to an Order of our Honorable Court of Sessions made the day of the date and agreeable to the petition of the Pet of our General Assembly in that Case made and provided both that Place and bind unto the said James Sinclair carrying away an African man of the age of ten years & six months old until he shall attain to the full age of Eighteen years During all which Time he his

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said Master hathfully that have the said full command every where
 gliding. Also she shall not at any time abuse poor said Master's service.
 Without leave, but in all things as a good and faithful servant
 shall behave towards his said Master, and the said James Sinclair Esq.
 Covenant promise and agree to and with the said Robert Parks that
 he will teach and instruct or cause to be taught and instructed the said
 Apprentice with one years schooling, also the art and Mystery of a ~~Smith~~
 and that he will constantly find and provide for the said Apprentice
 and servant sufficient Diet, washing, lodging and Apparel, tithing
 for, an Allowance, during the term aforesaid and also all other things
 necessary both in sickness and in health. In Witness whereof the Parties
