Know all men by these Presents that I William Hatcher of Caswell County and State of North Carolina hath bargained sold and Delivered unto Robert & Mary of the County and State aforesaid one Bay & Mare and one Red Cow Marked with a Crop in the left Ear one in under-Head in the right and two Calves marked with a Crop in the right Ear and an underhead in the left and one Feather Bed and one spinning Wheel one Iron and six Peggs with all my other Household Furniture for the consideration of thirty pounds paid in hand and I do hereby Warrant and defend the right of the said Robert & Mary unto the said Wainwright & Mary in this their several given cases my hand this 10th day of May 1792.

Know all men by these presents that we John Summers John Brown Hyam Dixon and John Grant all of the County of Caswell and State of North Carolina and his and jointly bound as to his Excellency the Chief Justice of the Superior Court in the sum of Five Thousand pounds to be paid to the said Alexander Martin assignee &c and his Executors and Assigns in which payment we and truly to be made we bind ourselves our heirs &c &c. Truly & Sincerely Signed by these Presents sealed with our seals &c. this 26th day of September 1792.

The Condition of the above Obligation is such that whereas the above bounden John Summers hath been by the County Court of Caswell nominated and appointed Register for the County aforesaid. If therefore the said John Summers shall faithfully and truly keep the said Office of Register by entering at large in Good Books with bound for that purpose all Deeds Grants and such other writings as are to be Registered and also keep safe his said Office and fully comply with his duty as Register as far as to the Tenor of the Law in that case made and provided, that then the above Obligation shall be void otherwise to remain in full force & effect.
