April Court 1799

This Indenture made the 22<sup>nd</sup> Day of April between Michael  
 Montgomery Esq<sup>r</sup> Sheriff for the County Court of Caswell and State of  
 North Carolina, in behalf of his fellow Justices of said County of the one  
 Part and Thomas Pendergast of the Other Part do hereby certify that the said  
 Michael Montgomery in pursuance to an order of our said Court made  
 the 22<sup>nd</sup> Day of April, and agreeable to the conditions of the Act of our General  
 Assembly in that behalf made and provided both, full place and bread  
 unto the said Thomas Pendergast, Samuel Morris, aged fifteen years & six  
 Months, until he shall attain to the age of twenty one years During all  
 which time he his said Master faithfully shall serve his said full command  
 every where he shall obey, he shall not at any Time absent himself from his  
 said Master's Service without leave in all things as good and faith-  
 -full servant behave towards his said Master and the said Thomas  
 Pendergast both severally to and with the said Michael Montgomery  
 that he will teach & instruct or cause to be taught and instructed the  
 said Samuel Morris, to Read and Write &c according to Law, also the art  
 and mystery of a Taylor, and that he shall constantly find and pro-  
 -vide for the Apparel of the said Samuel Morris, washing, lodging  
 and Apparel during the Term aforesaid, fitting for an Apprentice and  
 also all other things necessary both in his keep and in health, in  
 which wheresof the Parties to these presents have interchangedly  
 set their hands and affixed their seals the day and year above written  
 Signed sealed & delivered
