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In the Name of God Amen. I John Rice of the County of Carlisle
and State of North Carolina, being in a low state of health, but of perfect sense
and Memory, thanks be to God for the blessings, calling to mind the Mortality of my
Body, and knowing that it is Appointed unto man to Die: do now and Record
this my Last Will and Testament in Manner and form following, to wit, I commend
my Soul to God who Gave It, hoping thro' the Meritation of Jesus Christ to be
received of him; My Body to be decently buried at the discretion of my after named
Executors, Asking He remembered thro' Jesus Christ to Eternal Glory at the last Day,
And to what Wholly Cometh It hath pleased God to overcome with, Sorrow and
Languish them in Manner and form following, to wit, I thus to my beloved wife
Elizabeth during her life or widowhood, the land and Plantation wherein I now live
with thirty acres, together with three Leather Beds and two Chairs, Four Horses
and their Quartrings, her Share, Ten Bush of Wheat, five Bush to wit, a large
Hare and Broken baldfaced Hare and Lamb, And all the Household and Kitchen
Utensils, together with the Stock of Hogs.

Here I leave to Sarah Ann Rice, widow of my son John Rice Esq, thirty Cows
 of land Including the the Improvement whereto she now lives in the most conve-
 nient Manner to be well fed and enjoyed by her during her old agehood
 Here I also leave unto my beloved wife during her life or widowhood my Two
 Acres, to Celis, Will and Agnes —

I have sold out unto my Daughter Anna Williams one Negro woman Frank
 which she now has in her Possession during her life and at her Death, I leave
 the said Negro woman Frank and her Increase to be equally divided among
 the surviving Children of my Daughter Anna Williams to them their heirs
 or assigns forever

Item I will and Require that the residue of my estate not lost or given before except the plantation tools, which I sell now unto my beloved wife, be sold, and the money be applied to one of paying my Debts, and the balance of any is to be kept in the hands of my Executors for purposes hereafter to be mentioned.

Now my will and desire further is that after the Death or Salamarcings of my
 wife that all the estate lent to her both real and personal be sold, and out
 of the Money arising therefrom, I give and bequeath to my son Thomas Nine
 Thirty Pounds Virginia Money, and likewise to my Daughter Mary Nine
 Thirty Pounds Virginia Money, and likewise to my son William Nine
 Thirty Pounds Virginia Money, and likewise to my son Nathaniel Nine
 Thirty Pounds Virginia Money to them their Heirs or Assigns forever - and
 the Balance I leave to be equally Divided Among the Wives of my Children
 or their Heirs or Assigns forever.

Now I also leave that part of my estate which is lent to Sarah Rice at her death or Informances to be sold and the Money arising therefrom to be in like manner equally divided Among the Heirs of my Mother in their lives or before they die
