In the name of God Amen. I John Gates of the County of Caswell and State of North Carolina being weak in body and considering the shortness of this Transitory Life I make this my last will and Testament — Item I Give my soul to God hoping he will receive it through the Merit of Christ — Item I solemnly Give my body to the Court from whence it came to be born in a Christian Manner — Item I Give to my eldest son Allen Gates all the Land and Plantation where I now live also all the Land I bought of David Holt estate — Item I Give to my son William Gates the Land and Plantations that I bought of Samuel Pyles the Land that Archibald James bought of Thomas Robinson — Item I Give to my four youngest named Betty Gates, Milley Gates, Dotley Gates, Sadley Gates, and Henry Gates one Negro which named Coker and my Stock of all kinds and all my household and kitchen Furniture to be equally divided between my four Girls after paying my Just Debts. It is my desire that the two Sons Allen and William Gates should pay all my Just Debts that comes against the estate, that is to say my Tobacco that hangs that is now on the Ground must go to pay the Debts and as much of the Corn as can be Shaved. I name Robert Willson, Archibald James and Thomas Executors of my estate, in testimony whereof I have signed my hand and seal this 24th day of August 1798
