I now all more by these presents that I James Ray of Caswell County State of North Carolina, do constitute & obtain my own hand and seal my Attorney in fact, to act for me and in my name to sell or let my lands lying on Money back (being part of a larger tract which I have sold a part to Wensville (Drown) the said part remaining being One hundred forty Six Acres, & this to make he said land & Acquittances grant every other necessary act to the making of a good & indefeasible Title to the said lands, & in such manner could or were I personally present, & this to all my own & the Articles committed to his care. I will such things & things of his due hereby oblige myself fully to conform to & comply with - Witness my hand here this 10th day of Octo. 1797
