In the name of God Amen. I Thomas being of the
 County of Caswell and State of North Carolina being weak in
 body but of sound memory (being 62) on the 10th day of
 April in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred & ninety
 eight do make and publish this my last Will & Testament in the
 presence as follows that is to say Just. Agnes & Joseph being seen
 Wife Hannah Wade their Negroes Viz^t. James Sarah & Daniel
 and their Executors for ever. Also two hundred Acres of Land being
 the most convenient to my house and Orchard, or the premises to
 it to take them in her life time: a Slave known by name Yellow
 Mary, also her issue and Calves. I also my household and Kitchen
 Furniture, Also my Stocks & also also part of my choice sheep &
 my Mill and of her kind: I also leave the remaining part of my
 Negroes to wit Dem Castle, Phillis Lane, Milla to be drawn for by my
 Son and daughter that are now living in a proportionable
 valuation, and to them that do not draw or require to be made equal
 to the valuation of the Negroes that is drawn in money Viz^t the same
 to be paid by the rest of my children who draw with the Negroes in six months
 after the commencement of the Division. Also I give bequeath to my
 Dear Daughter Hannah ten one Negro Girl by name Rachel the
 same to be considered as part of her portion of my Negroes, ought to
 receive and if not equal to the rest to be made equal in money, and
 her increase, to her & her heirs forever. Also to my dear Granddaughter
 Nancy Lewis one Cow and half as her Mother's portion who is dead, the
 rest of my estate to her neither personal nor real. Also I give to
 my dear Grandson Divoria Hittower Five pounds as his Mother's estate
 who is dead, and as more, the said money to be paid to him by my
 children when he arrives to the age of twenty years - Also I give my
 my dear Son Lewis Hittower 20
 and above an equal part with the rest
 of my children - Also my Land to be equally divided amongst my

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 quality.
