To all persons to whom these presents may come, know ye that I Palmer Dixon
of the County of Caswell and State of North Carolina, do hereby constitute and
choose my Brother Charles Dixon of the same State and County, my
true and lawful attorney (in fact, to make do and execute) due on Due or Date of
conveyance to Bryan Dixon aforesaid, his certain attorney, his Miss, Esq^r, Adam^s
or others, for one certain tract or parcel of Land, in the aforesaid County
on Roanoke's Creek, being the tract wherein I lately resided containing
six Hundred and forty acres, being the land given me by my father, also
one tract of one Hundred and fifty acres, adjoining the aforesaid which I
purchased of Mr. Sam. Battle, also one tract of Twenty four acres,
adjoining Battalons and being (originally) a part of the same, and
which I purchased of Elton Gray, also one tract of Twenty three and an
half acres adjoining the said Battalons tract which I purchased of Peter
Smith (Roundhill) and one other tract of two acres and a half, lying adjoining
Charles Brown's tract which I bought of Joseph Nathaniel Dickson, and
any or all such conveyances by my said Attorney to make, I do hereby
make binding on me and obligate myself hereby, fully to confirm
and make binding on me, my Miss Esq^r, Adam^s and others, in as
full and ample a manner as though I myself in my own person
had made and executed the said Due or Date, and thereby convey all
the interest that I myself my said Esq^r, Adam^s have or may have therin
