at the Instance of John Crisp Wm^d) and made Oath that
he is not worth forty Shillings Sterling money, Over and
Above his Working Tools, Arms for Muster and Wearing
Apparel, And that he hath not at any time since his
Imprisonment or before, actually or Indirectly Sold
Assigned or Otherwise disposed off or made Oath in trust for
himself or Otherwise, any part of his estate in Order
to defraud his Creditors.

Samuel Nately was present and
being called on made Oath that he gave the above mentioned
Administrators Legal Notice of the time and place on
which the above was done.
