1st. I have named Pompey, 1 Negro Woman named Anny, 1 Negro

named Lincy, Item. It is my desire that all the prop-
-erty that I possess, be divided in five Equal
parts, & my wife Mary Bayd, to have two parts of
Same, & the other three parts to my three sons, In-
-teb. William & Stephen W. Bayd, It is also my
desire that one certain tract of Land Lying on
Leaunty line Creek in Leaswell Leantyp, & is a
Leantyping 502 acres, be sold for the best price that
can be got for it, to discharge my Just debts
& after the Death of wife Mary Bayd, The above
Mentioned property to be Equally divided
Among my Living Children, (that is to say)
my Son Amustad Bayd, William Bayd & John
W. Bayd, Item. It is my desire that Henry Cook
& James Chalmers be Appointed Executors to this
my Last will & Testament, In Virginia Also my
Son Amustad Bayd & Benjamin Williamson
in North Carolina to Execute this my Last will
& Testament, Revoking all other wills, what so
ever given under my hand & Seal, this second
Day of January in the year of our Lord one
Thousand seven hundred & ninety nine
