 of the State of North Carolina and County of Caswell, do constitute
 and appoint Samuel Nye of the County of Wake aforesaid
 my lawful Attorney, to sign seal and deliver a deed of
 Conveyance of land wherein I now live, lying and being
 on both sides of Flat River, joining Jefferson, William
 Green and Samuel Nye's lines, containing Ninety eight
 Acres be the same more or less, unto James Jay his heirs
 and assigns of the County and State aforesaid, And I do
 hereby empower the aforesaid Samuel Nye to execute the
 aforesaid Deed, out of the Land Office, and to make all
 manner of right according to law for me and in my
 name to all true Intents and purposes, in as full ample
 manner as I myself could have done were I present,
 to the said James Jay his heirs or assigns, and this
 shall be my full Power of Attorney Given under my
 hand and Seal this 20th day of Octo. 1785
