 delivering of these Presents, the receipt whereof
 I do hereby acknowledge, Have, for granted sold
 released & confirmed, and by these Presents do
 bargain, sell, release, grant & confirm unto
 the said David Shelton, a certain Tract or parcel
 of land, formerly entered in Lord Granville's Office
 by him the said Benjamin Carter, lying on
 both sides Raal's Snake Creek, in the County
 of Caswell and State of North Carolina, bounded
 as follows, beginning at a stake on his old line
 now (Hugh Dobbin's line) thence running West
 90 Chain to a Post Oak, thence South 1/4th Chain
 to a hickory, thence East 90 Chain to a hickory, thence
 North 10 Chain to a red oak, thence East 20 Chain
 to a hickory, thence North 1/4th Chain to the be-
 ginning, containing the in hundred Acre more
 or less, To have and to hold the said Land unto the
 only proper use and behoof of him the said David
 Shelton, his Heirs, Exrs, Admrs. or assigns forever.
 And the said Benjamin Carter for myself my
 heirs, Executors & Administrators do Warrant unto
