Caswell and Province of North Carolina being weak of body but of
sound Memory blessed be God for the same, At this 11th day of May
in the year of our Redemption One thousand seven hundred & eighty
four make and publish this my last Will and Testament in manner
as following that is to say, First I allow my body to be decently
buried and I commend my soul to my Redeemer in hopes of a
blessed & glorious life. I bequeath and lend to my Sons deceased
the third of my Land and half of the moveables and the best room in
the House and during life or widowhood and then to return to my
son Joseph Palmer. I bequeath to my son Joseph Palmer
my Land by Estimation all the acres and half, the moveables and
the rest of his Mothers death, also I bequeath to the rest
of my children each a small Bible, their Names as following
John Palmer Philip Palmer, Sarah Vanhook, Susannah Pellers
Barkabee Hale, Mary Wooster. I bequeath to son Thomas Palmer
my large Bible, I Order one acre of the said Land never
to be sold or granted where my son David is buried.

I also make and Ordain my Wife, Susannah, and my son Joseph
Palmer to be Executors of this my last Will and Testament
to Carry and see the same performed according to my true intent
and meaning In witness whereof I the said Thomas Palmer have
to this my last Will and Testament set my hand and seal the year
and day first above Written

Know all men by these presents that I Alexander Harrison of the
County of Caswell and State of North Carolina have for the
Valuable Consideration of the sum of sixty four pounds
four shillings and six pence Bargained sold and Delivered
unto Alexander Harrison of the County and State aforesaid
One Certain Negro Woman Slave by the Name of Litty about
thirty five or forty years old which said Negro Woman Slave
Litty Bargained sold & Delivered aforesaid do Warrant and
Defend & Grover unto the said Alexander Harrison his heirs
and assigns free and clear from the lawfull claim or
Demand whatsoever of me the said Alexander Harrison
my heirs Executors and Administrators and all and every
person or persons or their heirs or any thing having or
claiming in the said Negro above mentioned In witness
whereof the said Alexander Harrison have hereunto set
my hand and seal this 31 day of May Anno Domini 1791.
