 them one Cow Calf one Cow Lamb also one Sow Pigg
 Also I leave my Crop for the Maintenance of the family, Credit
 Ten Barrels of Corn and four Bushels of Wheat, that I Give
 unto my Grand Daughter Elizabeth Williams

Item I Give and bequeath unto e Mason Smith three hundred
 and Ten Acres of Land on the upper end of my land where he
 now lives also five chairs one Table to be sold and the Money to be
 equally Divided Between Willis Bucklegham Smith John Smith
 and Keadah Smith Also I leave that Willis Bucklegham Smith
 may live with e Mason Smith with all that he has till he comes
 of age and the said e Mason Smith to keep him and all I have
 left to the said Willis Bucklegham Smith till then and as for the
 Residue of my Estate I Will that it shall be sold by my
 Executors and the money arising from the sale be applied in dis-
 charging the Debts which may be due on the Estate

And Lastly I constitute and appoint my beloved Grandson e Mason
 Smith and my trusty friend e Nicholas e Murphy Executors to this
 my last Will and Testament and I do hereby revoke and deny
 all other Will or Wills by me made and all other Legacies and bequests
 in Writing whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Affixed my seal
 the year and day forth above written

 my negro Bunch Called East, One Horse called Derby all my
 Household Goods and Furniture, Six Head of Cattle three
 head of Hogs 12 head of Geese my Negro Boy called Kent
 to be sold at Six Months Credit the price of which I Give to my
 wife e Seasonah begotten of my wife likewise three Negroes Dubb
 Donah, Oland to my wife 2 Horses boomed e Partner among her
 Widdowhood and in case she Inter-marries the said two Horses to be
 sold for the use of my said lawfully begotten of my wife and
 in case my wife should not be shroued of a living child, all the
 property before mentioned to return to my wife e Seasonah
 my wearing apparel Saddle and Bridle one Gun I Give to my
 wife Lastly I constitute and appoint my wife and George
 Barber Executors to this my last Will and Testament In Witness
 whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Affixed my seal
 the day and year above written
