This Indenture made the 14th day of July Anno Domini 1786 Between  
William Moore Esq. in behalf of the Jurors & their Successors of the  
County Court of Hancock of the One Part and William Shufft of the  
Other Part Witnesseth that the said William Moore Esq. in  
Pursuance to an Order of the said County Court made the 14th day  
of July and according to the Directions of our Genl Assembly in that  
act made and provided, doth that place and bind unto the said  
William Shufft, Elyah Redman an African Man of the Age of one  
year with the said William Shufft Esq. to live after the Manner  
of an Apprentice and Servant until she shall attain the age  
of Twenty one years During all which time the said William  
his said Master shall faithfully serve his said Master's Commands  
every where Gladly Obedy he shall not at any time Absent  
himself from his said Master's Service but in all things as a  
good and faithful Servant behave Towards his said Master  
And the said William Shufft doth Covenant Promise and  
agree to and with the said William Moore that he will  
Teach and Instruct and cause to be Taught and Instructed  
the said Elyah Redman according to Law to Read Write  
&c. also the Art and Mystery of Planter and the like  
with constantly find and Provide for the said Apprentice  
During the Term aforesaid, sufficient Diet Washing  
Lodging and Apparel fitting for an Apprentice & also  
all other things necessary both in Sicknes and in Health  
And Witness above the Parties to these Presents hath  
interchangeably set their hands & seals this day and  
year first above Written
